

RULES AND REGULATIONS OF HOLLY TREE COUNTRY CLUB, INC.

The rules and regulations of Holly Tree Country Club are enforced by the General Manager under the guidance of the Board of Governors. All infractions of the rules and regulations are referred to the General Manager. Rules may be amended from time to time. All changes of the rules and regulations set forth by Holly Tree Country Club are made through the Board of Governors.

CLUBHOUSE

1. The Club will be open at hours as set by the Board of Governors.
2. The Grill and Bar serving hours will be posted at the Clubhouse and published monthly in the Holly Tree Newsletter.
3. Members and guests shall observe the following rules regarding clubhouse wearing apparel:
 - Informal attire, which is in good taste, is permitted.
 - Shoes must be worn at all times.
 - No bathing suits are permitted at any time.
 - No mesh or tank shirts or top wear briefer than waist length are allowed.
 - Denim jeans, denim shorts, hats and visors are permitted in the bar/grill and pro shop. Hats must be worn properly; i.e. hats with bills must be worn bill forward. Denim may be worn in the dining room if it conforms to style and proper attire.
 - Mesh or tank shirts for men, cutoff jeans for men or women, or top wear briefer than waist length is not permitted.
 - Shirts shall be tucked in at all times unless shirt is designed to hang out.
4. Members and their guests are expected to conduct themselves in a gentlemanly and ladylike manner. Rowdy behavior and the use of profanity are not permitted.
5. Members are required to sign their name and Club number for all purchases made or charges incurred at the Club.
6. Members are requested to make reservations for all club functions and members may be charged the cost of the function if not cancelled within 24 hours.
7. The locker rooms are for the use of all members over the age of eighteen (18). The rental of lockers is limited to one member per locker.
8. No personal or third party checks will be cashed by the club. Credit cards are accepted for use by both members and guests in the grill, dining room and pro shop.
9. Automobiles, pickup trucks or other vehicles must park in the spaces provided for this purpose. Parking is not allowed at the club house entrance or on Golf Club Drive. These areas are designated by the fire department as fire lanes.
10. Children must be restrained from romping around the Clubhouse premises. Member parents are fully responsible for any damage done to any Club property by member children or the member children's guests. Anyone under the age of 21 is not permitted to sit at the bar at any time. Groups with children under 21 years of age are not permitted in the Grille on Friday nights after 6PM. Persons under the age of 21 may order take out from the grille at the designated turn area.

11. No club property, including towels, glasses and china, shall be removed from the clubhouse. Glasses and bottles must not be taken on the golf course.
12. All articles found in the clubhouse or on club grounds should be turned into the pro shop where they will be held for identification and return to the owner.
13. Animals will not be allowed in the Clubhouse or on the Clubhouse lawn. The singular exception shall be the accommodation of Service Animals.
14. Members shall not reprimand Club employees. Any cause for complaint or constructive suggestions regarding the Club operations shall be referred directly to the General Manager.
15. Members and their family or guests are not permitted in the kitchen and service areas of the club, or in maintenance areas located on the club property.
16. Prior arrangements must be made through the Food & Beverage Manager for all food and beverage functions. When no food and beverage is ordered, the room charge will be at the published rates. If food and beverage is ordered and the cost is equal to or exceeds the published room rental rate, then the charge for the room rental will be waived, however, if the food and beverage ordered is less than the published room rental rate, only the difference from the food and beverage cost and the room rental rate will be charged. Members will receive a 20% discount from the published room rental rates in determining the actual charge for the room and in figuring differences in the food and beverage cost ordered and the room rental rate. No food or beverage items may be removed following private functions.
17. The Club will not be responsible for damage or accidents to members or their guests or to their property. We request that owners of property damaged on the premises make an immediate report in writing, to the General Manager or to the Club Office.
18. There shall be no solicitation of funds from members except for purposes as approved in writing by the Board of Governors.
19. Beverages and food not purchased at the club and personal coolers are not allowed to be brought on club property without permission of club management.
20. Members using sports facilities must register before using the facility, giving name and Club number and identification of their guest(s).
21. The Club operates under South Carolina regulations that require strict control over the handling and use of liquor. All members and guests must adhere to these regulations.
22. The Club shall not be responsible for errors, mistakes or dishonesty on the part of its employees nor for the loss or damage to any property entrusted by the member or the guests to any employee.
23. The Club will not be responsible for loss or damage from any cause to property left or kept by members in the Clubhouse, lockers, office, club storage room or elsewhere in any Club facility. Golf bags and tennis rackets are not allowed in the clubhouse.
24. No member or guest shall have any right of action against the Club or any of its officers or employees to recover losses or damages for injuries to the person or property of such members and guests or the emissary of such member or guest due to the negligence, malfeasance or misfeasance of its officers, governors, agents or employees.
